Will you, as proof of technical and business capacity, accept several projects with a total value of over EUR 2,000,000.00	<p>As it is stated in Contract notices article 16 – Selection criteria - Technical and professional capacity of candidate must be as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- it must have completed at least <b>1 project</b> of amount of at least <b>2.000.000,00 EUR related to construction and/or reconstruction and/or rehabilitation works of hydro technical facilities (civil and/or mechanical works)</b> which were implemented during the following period: <b>3 years</b> from the submission deadline.</li> </ul>
2.	In the section where you request welders with a diploma REL welded boards specify at least 4 welders, and in brackets write 6. Do you require 4 or 6 certified welders with a REL welded plate?	<p>In Contract notices article 16 – Selection criteria - Technical and professional capacity of candidate is stated:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The tenderer has <b>presently employed welders on full time basis</b> as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>minimum four (6) attested welders with diploma of REL weld plate</b></li> <li>- <b>minimum four (4) attested welders with diploma of REL welding of angular connections</b></li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>Quantity and quality requirements of works related to the tender procedure according to works dynamics are connected to welding works of certified welders. Contracting Authority requires:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>minimum six (6) attested welders with diploma of REL weld plate</b></li> <li>- <b>minimum four (4) attested welders with diploma of REL welding of angular connections</b></li> </ul>
