No.	Question	Answer
1.	As specified in Terms of participation – 8 Eligibility and rules of origin: "Participation is open to all legal persons [participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers] which are established in a Member State of the European Union or in a country or territory of the regions covered and/or authorised by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed (see also heading 22 below). All works, supplies and services under this contract must originate in one or more of these countries. Participation is also open to international organisations. The participation of natural persons is directly governed by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed." The question is: The countries outside EU are not specifically mentioned, so we would like ask you to clarify that weather Chinese company can participate in this tender as an individual or member of JV/consortium?	As it is stated in Contract notices article 22 – Legal basis, according to PRaG rules and programme rules, legal basis for the procurement is as follows:
